查尔斯·佩罗是17世纪的法国诗人和小 说家(《稿妈妈的故事》中的许多作品都出自 他手)。同时也是当时法国一位有代表性的评 论家。

查尔斯·佩罗早年继承父业、进入律师 界。后来在一些热爱文学和绘画的友人影响 下,从1654年开始执笔写作。

1670年, 他成为法兰西学院的一员。1687 年,他朗诵自己的诗作《路易大帝的世纪》,在

学院的新日两派之间引发了激烈的争论。

音尔斯・佩罗曾为他的孙子和孙女们写了童话集《 猜妈妈的故 事》、其中包括《睡美人》、《蓝胡子》、《小红帽》、《灰姑娘》和 《靴子里的猫》等。这些故事早已为中国的读者所熟悉。

在这部童话集中, 查尔斯・佩罗用简单的语言, 把成人世界和 梦幻王国巧妙地结合在了一起。当时的法国贵族对这些古老的故 事不周一顾、认为它们过于粗糙。但是、查尔斯・佩罗却主张让 孩子们从童话故事里学习一些道理。

查尔斯·佩罗的童话作品被世界各地的读者广泛接受和喜爱。 而他也被誉为"法国儿童文学之父"。

《灰姑娘》这篇童话是查尔斯·佩罗根据欧洲流传已久的"灰丫头(Cendrillon)"的故事翻译而来的。Cendrillon一词的本意是"从头到脚都是友",通常用来指那些整天在

厨房的炉灶前干活儿的人。在这个故事里,灰姑娘的继母和继母所生 的两个姐姐很恶毒地对待她,但她却从未因此而怨恨她们。她的好心 终于得到了回报——她嫁给了王子。

作者在这篇童话里去掉了原来故事中很多残酷的场面,结尾以喜 剧收场——灰姑娘最后宽恕了她的两个姐姐,还让她们嫁给了两位 贵族。

《睡美人》在这个故事里,美丽的公主被一位没有接到宴会 邀请的仙女诅咒,将在被荆棘缠绕的宫殿里沉睡一百年,只有王子的 到来才能解除这个魔法。为永恒的幸

福而付出的等待并不让人觉得厌烦,反而相当甜蜜。在很多童话逐渐被淡忘的今天,这篇童话蕴涵的浪漫意味让它至今仍散发着诱人的魅力。
