欧·亨利原名威廉·西德尼·波特(William Sydney Porter),是美国最著名的短篇小说家之一,曾被评论界誉为美国现代短篇小说之父。他出身于一个医师家庭,一生富于传奇,当过药房学徒、牧童、会计员、土地局办事员、新闻记者、银行出纳员。1901年,他迁居纽约,专门从事写作。

欧·亨利一生写了300多篇短篇小说,大部分反映了社会底层小人物的生活。这些作品以其幽默的生活情趣、"含泪微笑"的风格被誉为"美国生活的幽默百科全书"。他的作品往往以出人意料的结局收场,故事奇特又耐人寻味,情节有趣,语言生动。他的代表作《警察与赞美诗》、《麦琪的礼物》、《最后一片叶子》、《没有完的故事》等为他赢得了世界声誉。

《麦琪的礼物》讲述了这样一个故事: 贫穷但彼此相爱的年轻夫妇在圣诞节各自买了一件礼物——妻子卖掉自己引以为傲的长发,为丈夫买了一条白金表链: 而丈夫则卖掉了祖传的珍贵怀表,为妻子买下了她渴望已久的发梳。他们付出自己最宝贵的东西,却送出了无用的礼物,但彼此都收到了对方的爱和关怀。
