詹姆斯・巴里,英国著名小说家、剧作家。他出生于苏格兰一个织布工人家庭,是家中九个孩子里最小的一个。

巴里早年就对戏剧和文学评论非常感兴趣。大学毕业后,曾从事新闻工作两年。 1885年,他迁居伦敦,做新闻记者,并开始创作小说。《彼得·潘》是巴里最著名的

一部童话剧。巴里每天上下班都看见一群孩子在肯辛顿公园的草地上玩耍,扮演仙女、海盗等童话中的各种角色。巴里被他们的游戏吸引,也加入到其中。这几个孩子就是《彼得·潘》中几个小主人公的原型。1904年,《彼得·潘》在伦敦公演,引起巨大轰动。后来,巴里把它改写成童话故事。这篇童话被译成多种文字,受到世界各地读者的喜爱。

"是那只鳄鱼!"胡克大叫着跑掉了,斯米紧跟在他后面。


第3章 地下的家

p. 80-81


