






纳撒尼尔・霍桑 (1804-1864)

Nathaniel Hawthorne



纳撒尼尔·霍桑,美国文学界最伟大的 小说家之一。他出身于一个严格的清教徒家 庭,孩提时代就对阅读产生了强烈的兴趣。 大学毕业后,霍桑开始了写作生涯,为家乡 的一些期刊撰写文章和短篇小说。1837年, 他发表了第一部署名小说《故事新编》,由 此确立了主流作家的地位。霍桑以其《红字》 (1850)和《带有七个尖角阁的房子》(1851) 著称。艺术上,霍桑擅长揭示人物的内心冲

突和心理描写,想象丰富,常用象征手法,善于挖掘潜藏于事物背后的深刻意义,着重探讨人性和人的命运。

《人面巨石》是霍桑晚年撰写的一篇短篇小说,目的是探求人的理想形象。一个名为欧内斯特的男孩从自己的母

亲那里听说,一个注定要成为当代最伟大人物的孩子将会降生,而那位伟大人物的长相将会跟山崖上岩石形成的"人面巨石"一模一样。欧内斯特自己过着虔诚谦卑的生活,一心等待山崖上的形象化身在活人身上。随着时间的推移,他先后遇见了一个富商、一位英勇的军人和一名政客,可他们的样子都与山崖上的形象大相径庭。有一天,一位诗人在观看欧内斯特向村民发表演说时宣称:"看看欧内斯特,他跟'人面巨石'一模一样!"不过,在回家的路上,欧内斯特仍然在祈祷会有比他更聪明、更好的人出现,祈祷那个人会有跟"人面巨石"一样的长相。霍桑写过许多道德题材的作品,《人面巨石》即是其中之一。。
