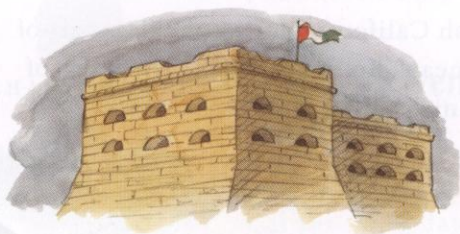

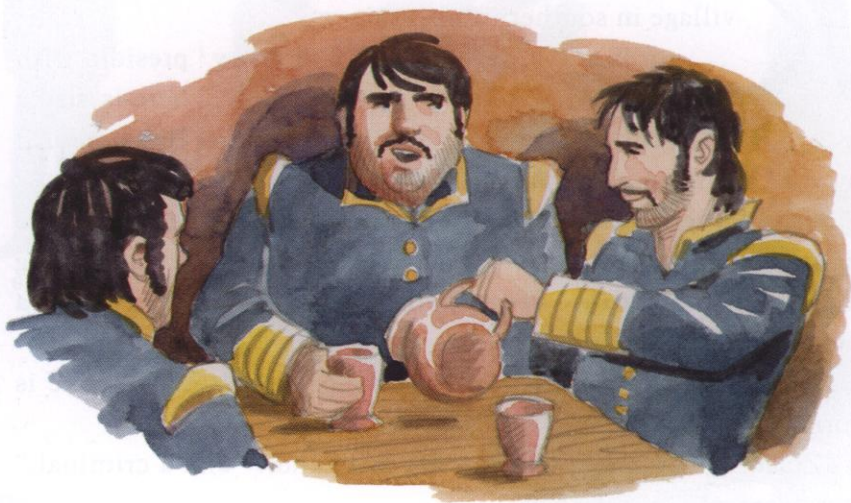
"He is the terror¹ of southern California," says another soldier.

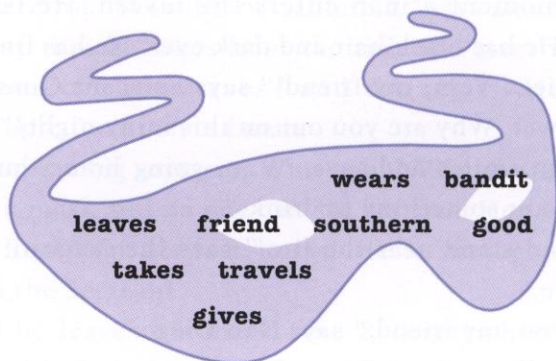

"You beat ¹ the poor natives. I am a friend of the natives. I am here to punish you."

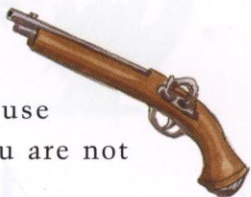
