Castles

What is a castle?

A castle is the home of a king or a very rich family. It protects ¹ the people who live there.

Castles have got high walls and small windows so they are difficult to attack ².

Castles are usually near rivers, near the sea, on hills or on mountains.

History of castles

In the 10th century people build small wooden castles in Europe.

In 1066 William the Conqueror attacks England. He is from Normandy in France. He builds the first big stone castles in England. He builds the Tower of London in about 1078. The Normans build about 80 stone castles in England.

There are a lot of stone castles in Europe in the 12th and 13th centuries. They are big and they can protect a lot of people.

Let's look at some important castles in Europe.

Bodiam Castle, East Sussex, England. This is an old medieval ³ castle with big, square walls and a moat ⁴ around it.

The Beast looks at Beauty's father and says, 'You must go away tomorrow. And don't come back! Do you understand?'


Beauty's father looks at the Beast and then at his daughter.





Flowers

There are about 200,000 different kinds of flowers in the world. Some are very small and others are very big, like the Giant ¹ Rafflesia.

Let's look at some of these flowers.

Flowers that grow in the desert

Some flowers grow in the desert. They need hot weather but they do not need much water. Some of these flowers are the Apache Plume, the Desert Lily, the Yucca and the Prickly Pear.



Flowers that grow on water

Flowers like the lotus, the water lily and the Louisiana Iris grow in water. These flowers need very warm weather. You can see them in ponds ² and lakes.
