


Part One

'No! No! I can't swim! I can't swim!' says Mowgli.


'Jump onto my back!' shouts Bagheera.



Mowgli, Bagheera and Baloo are very sad. The picnic is in the tiger's tummy!




'What's the matter?' asks Hathi, the elephant.

'No, I can't go back! I can't go back!' says Mowgli. 'I can't swim!!!'




'How old are you, Mowgli?' asks Jo the monkey.

'I can't swim!' says Mowgli.




- 'I can teach you to swim!' says Hathi.


'Good! Good boy, Mowgli!' say the animals.

'Yes!' shouts Baloo.


'Let's go back!' says Bagheera.

'Very good Mowgli. You can swim now!!!'




'Where is the tiger?' asks Mowgli.
