



Where is the harp?


The Queen's harp is not here!

Freddy: OK. I understand. No hamburgers today!






Freddy: Listen...

Robin: Yes! Imagine... 500 gold pieces and... lots


and lots of hamburgers!

Freddy: Right. Stand in a line.


The gardener here.

Everyone: His thumbs are black. Freddy: And now the carpenter.


Everyone: His thumbs are... clean!

Freddy: Thank you, Your Majesty!


Queen: Please have dinner with us at the castle.

I must go home to her.


