


'You must pull the brass ring to open the door.


Then you can go in,' said the magician.


Aladdin pulled the ring. The stone

'No! Give me the lamp,' said Aladdin. 'It's a magic lamp!'


Whoosh! Whoosh!!! There was a blue, red, orange and green cloud in the house.


'I am the genie of the lamp,' said the genie. 'Your wish is my command.'

'Yes, Princess,' said the magician. 'And now we must go – far away, to my country!'


The magician took the lamp, and rubbed it.

Whoosh! Whoosh!! There was a blue, red, orange and green cloud in the garden.


'I am the genie of the lamp,' said the genie. 'Your wish is my command'.

'Thank you,' said the magician.


Suddenly, the magician was asleep!

'Aladdin, where's the magician?' asked the Emperor.


'Ah!' said Aladdin. 'He's far away, in the desert... and he can stay there forever!'
