human family: mother, father, boy.




Slimey likes vegetable soup, peas, carrots and spinach. He likes milk, tea and fresh water.

He likes the cellar.


The house is always tidy, but the cellar is a bit damp

the door.






Candid wants to live in a messy place. He puts some furniture in a pile against the door.


Now he is safe.

He puts a chair on top and sits down on it.




That's how Candid notices a ring in the floor.

Candid pulls.


Slimey pushes.

The trapdoor is open.


Candid climbs out.

But be careful! There is a warrior on every bridge.


If you want to cross the bridge you can: pay (but remember you have only six coins).

The winner is the first to arrive at the castle




