






Robo likes his new teacher. Mrs. Jones makes her students use their imagination. Robo likes that.


"Everybody has a favorite place," Mrs. Jones says to the class.


"I have so many. How can I choose just one?"












"Then there is Grandpa's house.


Pop Pop likes to play tricks on me."






"The swimming pool is a cool place, especially in the summer.

It's best to learn to swim the right way."










"Sometimes, the neighborhood playhouse has funny and scary shows. I like them all."

"That's very good," Mrs. Jones says with a smile.




Robo smiles, too, because later in the afternoon he will visit his favorite place.
